Important Reminders



ANNUAL AIR CONDITIONING MAINTENANCE REMINDER

Please be advised the air conditioning unit inside your home requires maintenance and <u>annual cleaning</u>. This is a homeowner responsibility.

Please be sure to schedule your air conditioning unit maintenance as soon as possible. This maintenance should include replacing the air filter with a new one, cleaning the coils inside the air conditioning unit and checking to make sure the condensate line is clear.

FIRE PREVENTION TIPS:

- If you feel that your dryer vent is clogged or is clogging, please contact the HOA office to schedule a dryer vent cleaning.
- Ensure you clean the dryer lint trap/filter after every use.
- According to the National Fire Protection Association, (NFPA), only one heatproducing appliance (such as a coffee maker, toaster, space heater, etc.) should be plugged into a receptacle outlet at a time.
- According to the NFPA: major appliances (refrigerators, dryers, washers, stoves, air conditioners, microwave ovens, etc.) should be plugged directly into a wall receptacle outlet. Extension cords and plug strips should not be used.
- IMPORTANT REMINDER from the NFPA: call a qualified electrician or your landlord if you have:
 - Frequent problems with blowing fuses or tripping circuit breakers.
 - Discolored or warm wall outlets
 - A burning or rubbery smell coming from an appliance.
 - Sparks from an outlet.
